There are three steps to complete the application process for “Georgia and Clem Richardson Memorial Scholarship.”

1. Go to <https://factsmgt.com/parent-resources/grant-and-aid/> to apply for Financial Aid through FACTS for the 2018-2019 school year.
2. Complete the attached application and return it in a sealed envelope to the front office of Notre Dame High School. Please address the envelope to “**Georgia and Clem Richardson Memorial Scholarship**”. If you prefer, you may mail the completed application to Notre Dame Foundation, 455 Palma Drive, Salinas CA 93901, postmarked no later than April 20, 2018.
3. Essay: We would like to know more about you. The personal essay is your opportunity to address the Notre Dame High School Foundation Scholarship Committee and provide information that we might not learn from the rest of your application. You may choose to discuss one of the following topics.
 - a. A significant life experiences that may have affected your educational development, such as growing up in an economically or educationally disadvantaged environment or coping with personal or family hardships.
 - b. A significant leadership or extracurricular activities.
 - c. A significant experiences in community service or employment.

Student will be scored on content as well as form (spelling, grammar and punctuation) will be considered. Your statement must be typed (character size 12) and on 8 X 11 white paper. It should be at least one full page but not more than two. Double space your lines and use only one side of each sheet. Additional pages will not be accepted. Attach your pages to your application. Print your name at the top of each page.

Place your application in an envelope and seal it. Print Notre Dame Foundation, Georgia and Clem Richardson Award on the envelope. Give the envelope to the front office at Notre Dame High School no later than April 20, 2018.

CLEM AND GEORGIA RICHARDSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Clement George "Clem" Richardson was born in San Francisco in 1917, and his wife Georgia Fano Richardson was born on the Fano Ranch in Gonzales in 1919. Clem attended St. Ignatius High School until his mother's sudden death at which time he lived with his older sister in Salinas. He graduated from Salinas High and continued his education at Salinas Jr. College, Creighton University, and eventually graduated from Stanford University in 1940. Georgia attended local Gonzales schools and graduated from Stanford University in 1941.

Clem and Georgia were married a week before the bombing of Pearl Harbor. During WW II, Clem was a squadron leader of the 101 Airborne Division. Clem's plane was one of the first over Normandy Beach on D-Day. Following the war, he returned to Salinas and was employed at Sturdy Oil Company in Salinas.

Together, they raised their five children. Ruth, Jeannie and Alice were instructed by the Notre Dame Sisters at Palma High School. Sheila is a member Notre Dame High School's first graduating class. Their son, Clem graduated from Palma High School. Clem and Georgia insisted their children attend Catholic schools, and it was never a question of "if" they were going to college but "where." Their Catholic faith, family, education, a strong work ethic, and deep love of family and sports, (especially Stanford football and golf) was the corner of Clem and Georgia's life.

Clem and Georgia's memory is honored with the Clem and Georgia Richardson Memorial Scholarship awarded to a Notre Dame student with an outstanding grade point average.
