Notre Dame High School was founded in 1951 as the girls' division of Palma High School under the direction of the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur. During the 1964-65 academic year, the girls division was moved to its current location as a separate all girls' institution. Notre Dame is a Catholic High School in the Diocese of Monterey, has 202 students and 32 faculty and staff members.
