### HISTORY

Notre Dame High School was founded in 1951 as the girls' division of Palma High School under the direction of the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur. During the 1964-65 academic year, the girls division was moved to its current location as a separate all girls' institution. Notre Dame is a Catholic High School in the Diocese of Monterey, has 202 students and 32 faculty and staff members.

### MISSION STATEMENT

Notre Dame is a college preparatory Catholic high school for young women who seek wisdom, develop as leaders, and model Christ in service to others.

### ADMISSIONS

Notre Dame High School admits students without regard to race, creed or national origin. Applicants are considered for admissions based upon their demonstrated desire to attend NDHS; previous academic achievement; evaluations from the current school; and performance on the entrance test (HSPT).

### LOCATION

Notre Dame High School is located in south Salinas and serves the Salinas Valley and Monterey Peninsula, South Monterey as well as Santa Cruz, San Benito and Southern Santa Clara counties.

### COVID-19 Response

Students are participating in synchronous distance learning until Monterey County is cleared to allow safe in-person instruction. The academic rigor is consistent with in-person classes and students will receive a letter grade. All sports are scheduled to start in January 2021. Clubs & leadership will take place virtually for the time being.
